I have returned to practicing and refining my painting skills in 2016 – focussing on landscape and street scenes. I find inspiration from artists such as: Milind Mulick, Alvaro Castagnet, Sergei Kurbatov, Chien Chung-Wei and Herman Pekel.





SIF Shahid is a Sydney based watercolour artist originally from Dhaka, Bangladesh. He moved to Sydney in 2009 to further his studies and professional career at the University, where he completed his Bachelor's Degree in Computer Engineering.

ASIF is known for his love of watercolours, expressive landscapes and evocative street scenes shaped by a deep interest in composition, colour theory and the effects of light and atmosphere, often creating a sense of mood or emotion through the depiction of mist, fog, or diffused light.

He enjoys simplifying complex subjects to reveal their essence using light, shapes and colour. In his demonstration he will simplify a landscape while maintaining a strong sense of atmosphere, rhythm, composition and precise confident brushstrokes.

He will demonstrate how the interplay of light, shape and colour capture both beauty and emotion of the place.
